### 2020 ORDINANCE 10

AN ORDINANCE to amend Chapter 275 of the Code relating to: Shoreland, Wetland and Floodplain Zoning.

*The people of the County of Washington, represented in the Board of Supervisors, do ordain as follows:*

**SECTION 1.** The Land Use and Planning Committee approved the amendments to Chapter 275 of the Washington County Code, attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference.

**SECTION 2.** Approving the attached, amended chapter also authorizes the necessary, nonsubstantive changes to the text throughout the entire County Code without further County Board action thereby eliminating the need to specifically display each change herein.

**SECTION 3. EFFECTIVE DATE.** This ordinance shall become effective upon passage by the Board of Supervisors, the County Executive and publication as provided by law.
