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9 **Transfer from Strategic Priorities Fund to the Treasurer’s Office for**
10 **Temporary Additional Staffing**

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12 **WHEREAS**, the Washington County Treasurer filed Notification of Non-Candidacy
13 papers with the County Clerk’s Office on April 16, 2020; and

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15 **WHEREAS**, the Treasurer’s Office currently has very limited staff and as such, there is a
16 need to hire and train a temporary Assistant County Treasurer to maintain continuity of operations
17 as a result of the announced retirement of the current County Treasurer; and

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19 **WHEREAS**, the Treasurer’s Office does not have funds budgeted for additional personnel
20 in 2020 and does not plan to add permanent budgeted ongoing operating costs beyond the sworn-
21 in date of the newly elected County Treasurer in January 2021; and

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23 **WHEREAS**, section 15-37C of the Washington County Code states that appropriation of
24 funds not provided for in the adopted Annual Operating Budget or Capital Improvement Plan shall
25 be made upon recommendation of the appropriate Standing Committee and by resolution adopted
26 by the County Board;

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28 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Washington County Board of
29 Supervisors that an amount of \$50,000 is hereby transferred from the Strategic Priorities Fund to
30 the Treasurer’s Office account to fund the additional personnel for the purpose of assisting the
31 Office in maintaining continuity of operations upon the retirement of the current Treasurer.

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33 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that should there remain any funds from the transfer that
34 are not used for the purpose as specifically set forth in this Resolution, said funds shall be returned
35 to the Strategic Priorities Fund.
