Dear Residents & Families:

We were informed we have three additional staff members within the health center who have tested positive for COVID-19. These additional cases puts our total at 21 staff members and 3 residents who have tested positive for the month of January. Some of the staff who previously tested positive are off of quarantine, back to work, and feeling well; which we are grateful for.

Our PPE protocol remains the same as we are utilizing our available PPE to our best digression and using where needed. We are continuing to educate our staff to practice the Core Principles of COVID-19 Infection Prevention outside of work. This includes social distancing, wearing a mask, and getting vaccinated; we encourage all to do the same.

Per CMS guidelines we are required to keep visitation open. As a facility, we are still **HIGHLY DISCOURAGING VISITATION AT THIS TIME**. Visiting during an outbreak can lead to the potential risk of transmission of COVID-19, which can lead to illness, hospitalization, and even death. If you choose to visit a resident on 3rd floor we are asking all visitors to wear an N95 mask, face shield, gown and gloves. All other units we are asking visitors wear an N95 mask and face shield. PPE is available at the reception desk upon arrival.
