

Hello Families and Residents,

It has been a busy week with a lot of visitors taking advantage of our new indoor visitor policy. Our visitors bring a new sense of life and energy into the building that we were missing!

We had testing this week for all staff on Tuesday. We have not received all the results back yet but the ones we do have; have all been negative. As long as these, and any resident signs or symptoms continue to be negative we will keep moving forward with our indoor visits.

Some reminders and notes for our visitors

- Visiting hours are **Monday-Friday 9:00am-7:30pm and Saturday and Sunday 8:00am-3:00pm**. The front doors are locked outside of those hours.
If you are here after hours, please let a nurse know so they can let you in or out of the building. Please be patient and conscientious as our staff's main role is for our residents. **DO NOT TRY PRYING OPEN THE FRONT DOORS**. This leaves a dangerous situation for our residents and staff.
- Please stay in resident's room or patio during the duration of your visit.
- **Do not wander halls** or track down staff. If you need to speak to a staff member, please put the call light on in resident's room and a staff member will assist you as soon as they are able.
- Masks must be worn by both staff and residents during the visit at this time.
- Do not gather in the lobby with residents.
- Overnight visits are not allowed at this time. (Compassionate visits may provide an exception.)
- If you know another family member is coming to visit a resident check what time they are coming so we can avoid having more than two visitors in a room. We are limiting guests to two per resident at this time.

We want these visits to be both safe for residents and visitors alike so we ask that you please abide by the rules we have put in place as we want to continue to see your smiling faces!
